Commissary Corner

Recipe of the day: From the Dutch Oven Cook Book by J. Larsen

Peach Cinnamon Spice Cobbler

12" oven with foil; 10-12 bottom briquettes

Coat foil with butter or margarine. Add: 1 29 oz can sliced peaches with juice.

Top with: 1/2 square of butter, cut into pats, 1/2-3/4 cup brown sugar; 1-1 1/2 teaspoons of cinnamon

Sprinkle on top (but do not mix) 1 package Spice Cake Mix

Add another 29 oz can of sliced peaches, with juice.

Dot again with 1/2 square of butter, cuts into pats

Sprinkle with 1/2-3/4 cup brown sugar 1 1/2 teaspoons cinnamon

Mix 1 spice cake mix as directed on package. Pour over other ingredients and level top

Please over heat. Cook from the bottom, using more of a bubblyboil. Cobbler is finished when cake bakes through, about 1 1/2 hours. Cool and serve with whipped cream, if desired


